And one little heart to love him still

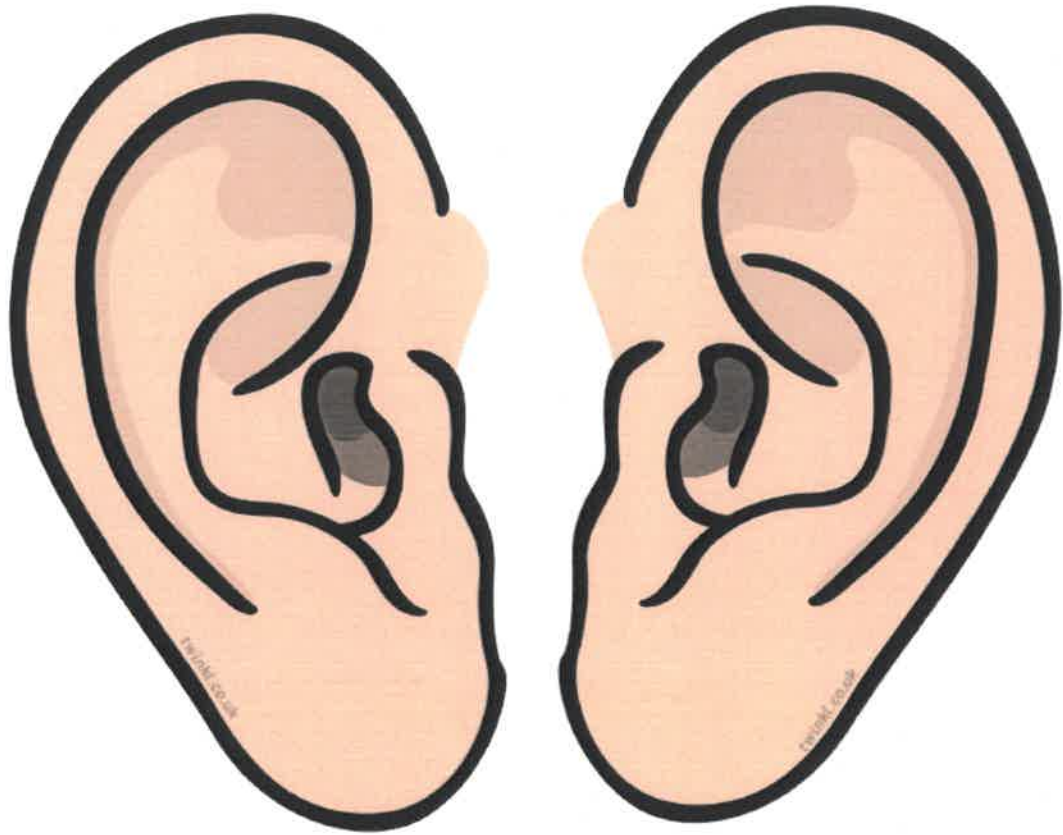


God also wants us to listen to his word.

WITH THE HELP OF AN ADULT

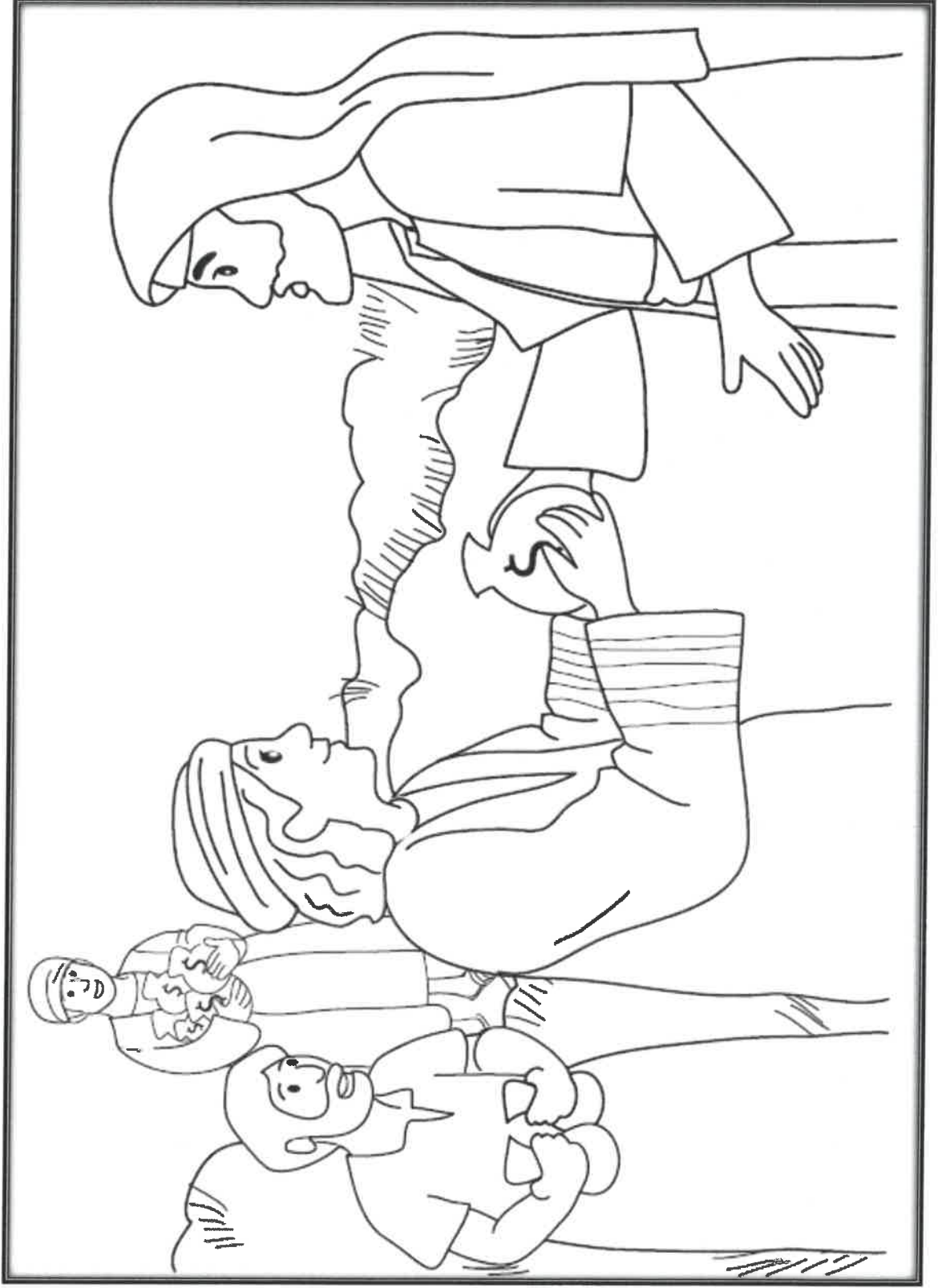
1. Make a Head Band out of old newspaper or card
